- Ensuring our facilities are constructed and well maintained, and our operations are performed to meet, or exceed all applicable legislative obligations and regulatory requirements to protect the public from risks arising from the services we provide and the networks we operate.
- Cultivate a culture that encourages employees, contractors, and public to make safety a priority and shared responsibility based upon the internal responsibility system and ingrain these values throughout our business.
- Act with urgency to respond or investigate any unsafe conditions or events, and by ensuring management systems include proactive measures goal setting, performance measures, reporting, training, and monitoring based on both leading and lagging indicators to drive continual improvement.
