

Emera to support newcomers reach their career goals with renewed investment in ISANS

We are proud to announce the launch of a new program with our partners at Immigrant Services Association of Nova Scotia (ISANS) – ***Drive Your Career*** powered by Emera. With Emera’s \$81,000 investment, this program will support job-ready immigrant professionals in their journey towards achieving their career goals as they settle into life in Nova Scotia. This investment comes from Emera’s Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Fund, which was established to support organizations and initiatives directly advancing inclusion and diversity in our communities. Partnering with ISANS reflects our journey towards an inclusive and diverse culture and aligns with our commitment to give back to the communities where our employees live and work.

Drive Your Career will provide more than 40 immigrant professionals with benefits such as improved community connections, expanded professional networks, and better preparation for the local job market, through 3 project components aimed to pave the way for successful integration into the workforce in Nova Scotia.

- Through the **Professional Practice Program**, individuals without Canadian workplace experience will be matched with a local employer, including Emera, to complete a 2-to-6 week placement related to their profession.
- The **Professional Mentorship Program** will connect immigrant professionals with mentors who work in their field, enhancing their understanding of the profession within the Canadian context.
- Depending on the needs of the participant, ***Drive Your Career*** will connect them with other **ISANS programs and services** like Employment Counselling and English in the Workplace.

This builds on Emera’s support for ISANS, first announced in 2021, for a total investment of more than \$380,000, impacting nearly 200 immigrant youth and adults in Nova Scotia. Together, our support is helping to create an inclusive community where we can all belong.
